7. In addition to the Gazetted/Restricted Holidays and Holidays under N.I. Act-1881, all 2nd and 4th Saturday also be observed as Holidays. The Deputy Commissioners are allowed as in previous years to declare any 1st which may be of local significance as local Holiday except Kamrup (M). General Administration Department declare one day as local holiday for Kamrup(M) District.

8. These Holidays will not be automatically applicable to the Educational Institutions, Medical/Engineering unless they adopt the list but it is desirable that the number of holidays is decreased for Educational Inst Medical/Engineering Colleges etc. and they adopt academic calendars decreasing the number of holidays.
